### **AOSOS Installs Eleventh Production of Web-Based Application in Seven States**

America's One Stop Operating System (AOSOS) Consortium recently installed the eleventh production build of its web-based case management and reporting system in Hawaii, Kentucky, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, Rhode Island and the Virgin Islands.

Touting 13 major enhancements in its latest release, AOSOS Version 3.1 highlights include navigational enhancements between customer, employer and job order records and also navigational enhancements between Comprehensive Assessment and the Customer Services modules. These enhancements were developed to facilitate the use of AOSOS by front line staff. The 3.1 documentation details all the enhancements and modifications of this version release. Additionally, a detailed technical architecture document has been created and included with Version 3.1.

AOSOS is funded by the US Department of Labor and state subscriptions, and was developed through collaboration of state staff working through America's Job Bank Service Center (AJBSC) and New York based application developer, Navisite.

The Consortium is reaping the benefits of the developer's fast-tracked pace toward delivering a more dynamic and interactive application. Encouraged by enthusiastic and overwhelmingly positive responses from front line staff using AOSOS, the Consortium invites other states to take advantage of this application designed by and for workforce professionals. The system's multi-agency design makes it a viable and effective tool for the diverse partners that share critical roles under the Workforce Investment Act (WIA).
