When did AOSOS become operational in your state?	<b>July 2, 2001</b>
What software/system did your state convert from?	<b>A state built application running on a mainframe.</b>
Do you support your own hardware or is your hardware hosted? If you support your own, list the hardware used by your state.	<b>Nevada uses and supports our own hardware. The hardware includes: 10 Sun servers (1 for data warehouse, 1 for production database and 1 for a test database, 2 used for mainframe interface and 5 used for transactions. There are also 5 Cisco routers used.</b>
How does your state use the API process?	<b>NV utilizes the APPC interface between our mainframe and the Oracle servers and then creating XML for the APIs. The interfaces are with our UI, Re-employment, state specific program (CEP), IVRU and with LWIB systems.</b>
Identify what resources (staff) support & maintain AOSOS in your state?	<b>The following staff maintain and support AOSOS, but not 100% of their time. 3 liaison user staff for administration (includes participation in the AOSOS Scope and Steering Committees), 2 help desk staff, 2 Oracle DBA's, 1 Oracle Discoverer reporting tool administrator, 1 API gateway interface programmer, 2 AOSOS application programmers and 1 applications team lead staff.</b>
