Why did your state choose AOSOS?	The State needed to replace two obsolete legacy systems (Wagner-Peyser & JTPA) and implement a single WIA compliant case management and reporting system capable of supporting the business needs of many One-Stop system partners and their programs. The vision for AOSOS best met the State's strategic technology plan and provided the State with the opportunity to participate in the specification and development of the system. As its \$25M+ development and initial maintenance were 100% federally funded and the license and source code was available at no cost, AOSOS also represented the most cost effective system choice.
